

[Important] Announcement of a Change in the Web Conference Tool to Be Used for the Poster Sessions

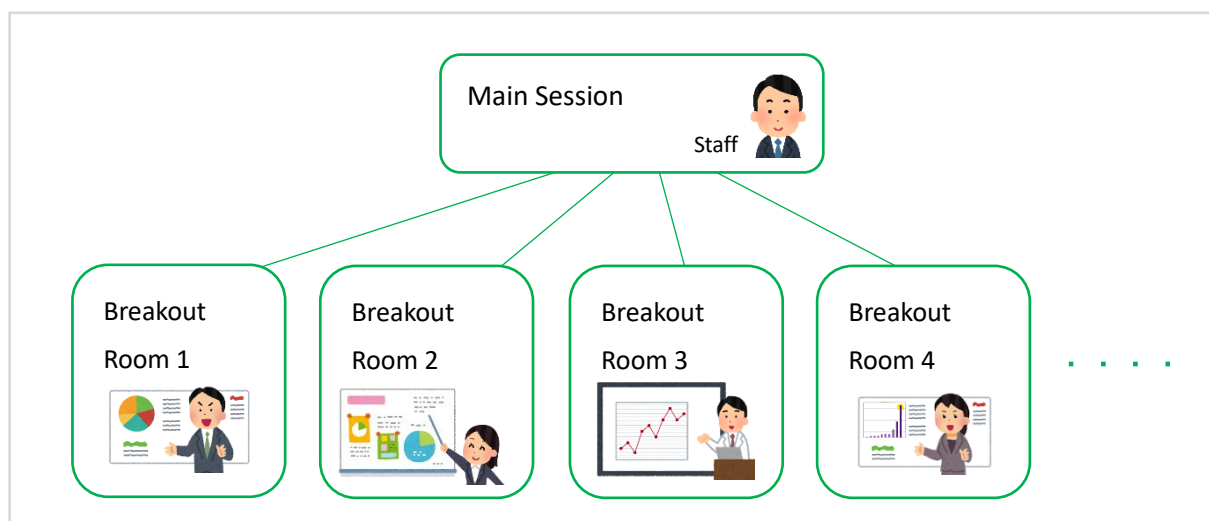
The 101st Annual Meeting Organizing Committee is hereby announcing a change in the web conferencing tool to be used for the poster sessions from Remo Conference (hereafter Remo) to Zoom Meeting (breakout room).

Reasons for the change

In June 2020, the Organizing Committee considered the tools to be used for the poster sessions and announced the use of Remo in "Chemistry and Industry" and on the website of the Annual Meeting. Subsequently, after receiving information about updates to Zoom and Remo, we have decided to change to Zoom meeting (breakout room) for the poster sessions because it will be unnecessary to use two different tools for oral and poster presentations.

What is "breakout room"?

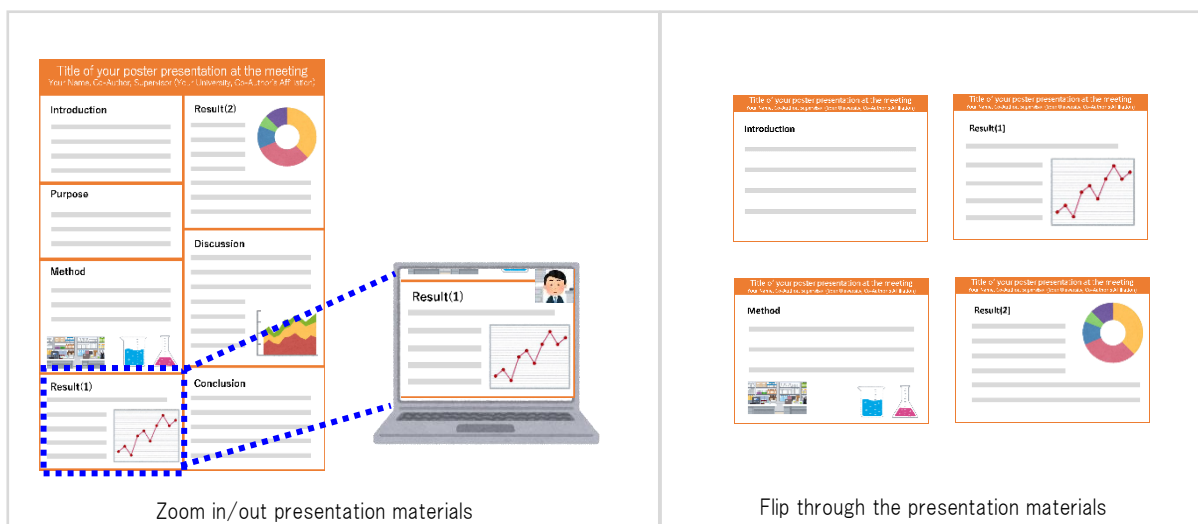
It is one of the functions of Zoom Meeting. Organizer can divide the Zoom Meeting into separate rooms. Participants can move freely between breakout rooms.



How to make a poster presentation

Speakers will use Zoom's screen sharing function.

- Please prepare your presentation materials to be viewed through a PC screen in landscape orientation.
- The presentation materials can be in one page or in multiple pages.
- With Zoom's screen sharing function, the presenter should zoom in/out or flip through the presentation materials. The whiteboard function of Remo cannot be used.

- The breakout room function may not be available if you have an early version of the Zoom Desktop Client or if you use the browser version (Web Client). Be sure to [download the latest version of the Zoom Desktop Client](#) and install it on your PC.
- If you will access from your institution, please confirm with your institution's IT department beforehand that the PC and Internet you will be using are compliant with the [supported environment for Zoom](#).
