What Participants Need to Prepare

■ PC

Smartphones and tablets are not recommended.

■ Internet connection

A wired connection or high-speed Wi-Fi is recommended.

■ Microphone, Speaker

Built-in devices are acceptable.

■ Web camera

Built-in devices are acceptable.

- Participants shall bear the costs for the above.
- CSJ will arrange for Zoom. Participants do not need to subscribe to a paid plan.
- If you are just a listener, you do not need to prepare a microphone and a web camera. However, please use them when asking a question to a speaker in the Zoom Meeting (Oral A/B, Poster).

Recommended Environment

- Please make sure that your environment meets Zoom's requirements from the following website.

- The browser version (Web Client) is not recommended since its functions are limited.
